Effective Teaching Pedagogy in **Management Education**

About the program

Today the profession of management teaching has become quite challenging. Business school teachers are expected to be both effective teachers and researchers as well. A teacher can "teach" all day long and cover an extensive amount of material, but if students haven't learnt the material, the exercise is an enormous waste of time and energy. Being an educator is not just about sharing knowledge; it is about making sure that learners truly integrate this knowledge and derive learning out of it. Any teaching that does not result in effective learning is useless.

Therefore, to be an effective teacher, one needs to be able to deliver the domain knowledge using the most suitable pedagogical tools. Pedagogy is the art and science of teaching that bestows the precise improvement required for an effective teaching learning outcome. Pedagogy, incorporating an assortment of teaching strategies that support intellectual engagement, connect to the wider world, supportive class room environment and recognition of differences should be implemented across all key learnings. An effective teacher is also required to remain at the frontiers of knowledge in his/her areas of subject expertise and gain working knowledge of other domains as management is essentially interdisciplinary. For this, every teacher needs to continuously upgrade himself/herself by engaging in research.

The FDP focuses on equipping the participants with skills required for designing and using right mix of pedagogical tools in management courses. In this FDP lectures, audio visual, case method, action learning, role plays and simulations will be introduced and explained. The effective use of the pedagogic tools will be demonstrated.
