For each technical event there will be various teams who will fight for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place. Each team will be awarded points on the basis of there performance.


For sport event there will only two position 1st and 2nd. The team which gets 1st position will be awarded with 10 points and the team who gets 2nd position will be given 9 points respectively.
